A core set of basic chords in open position that ALL Ukulele players should know.

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A diminished seventh (dim7, °) chord is usually played in place of a diminished chord.

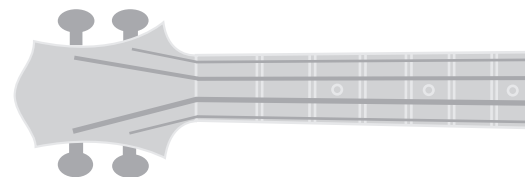
Any one of the notes of a dmin7 or augmented (aug, +) chord can be the root or letter name of the chord.

NOTE: All chord Fingerings are recommended but not mandatory.

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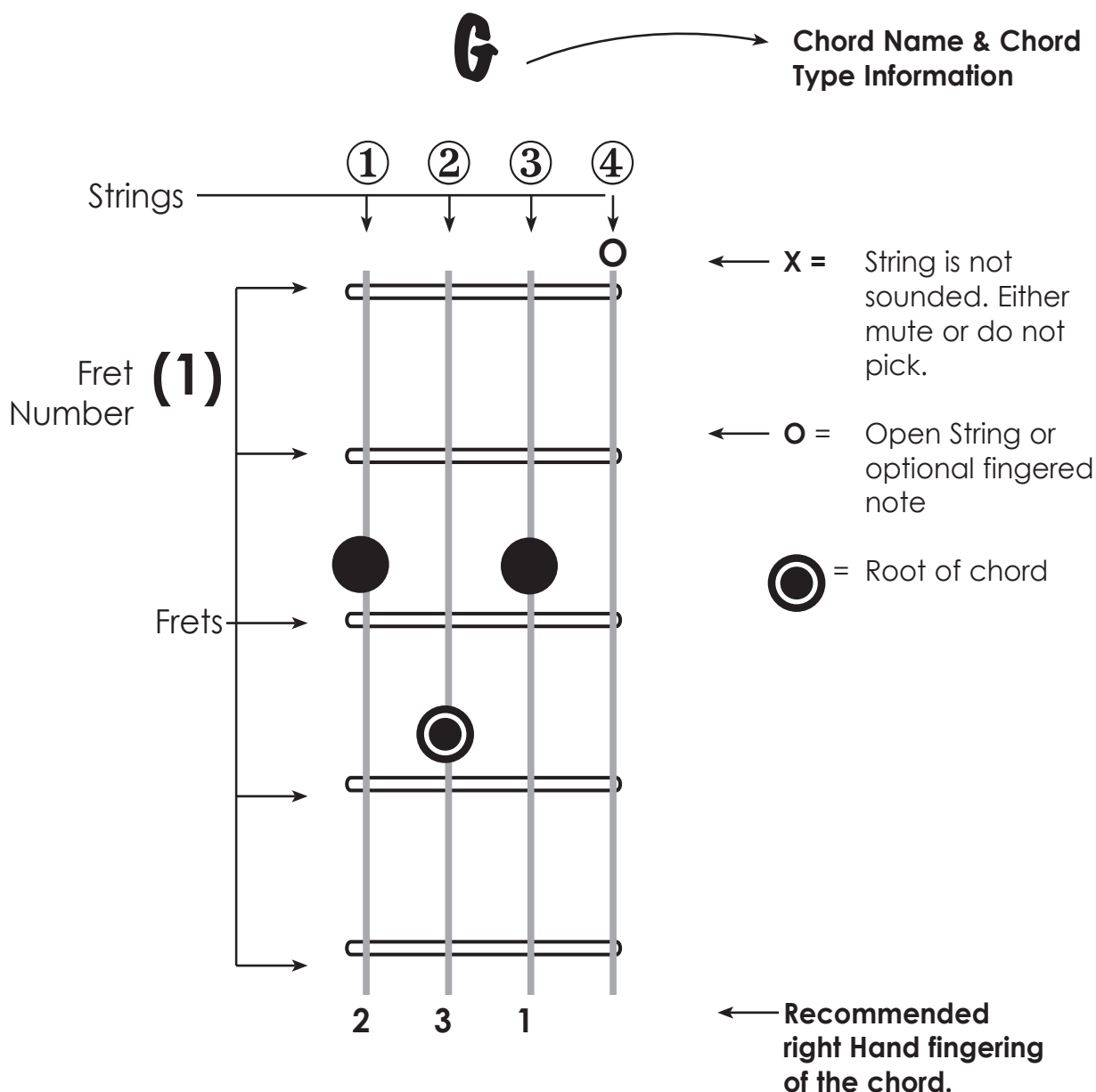
