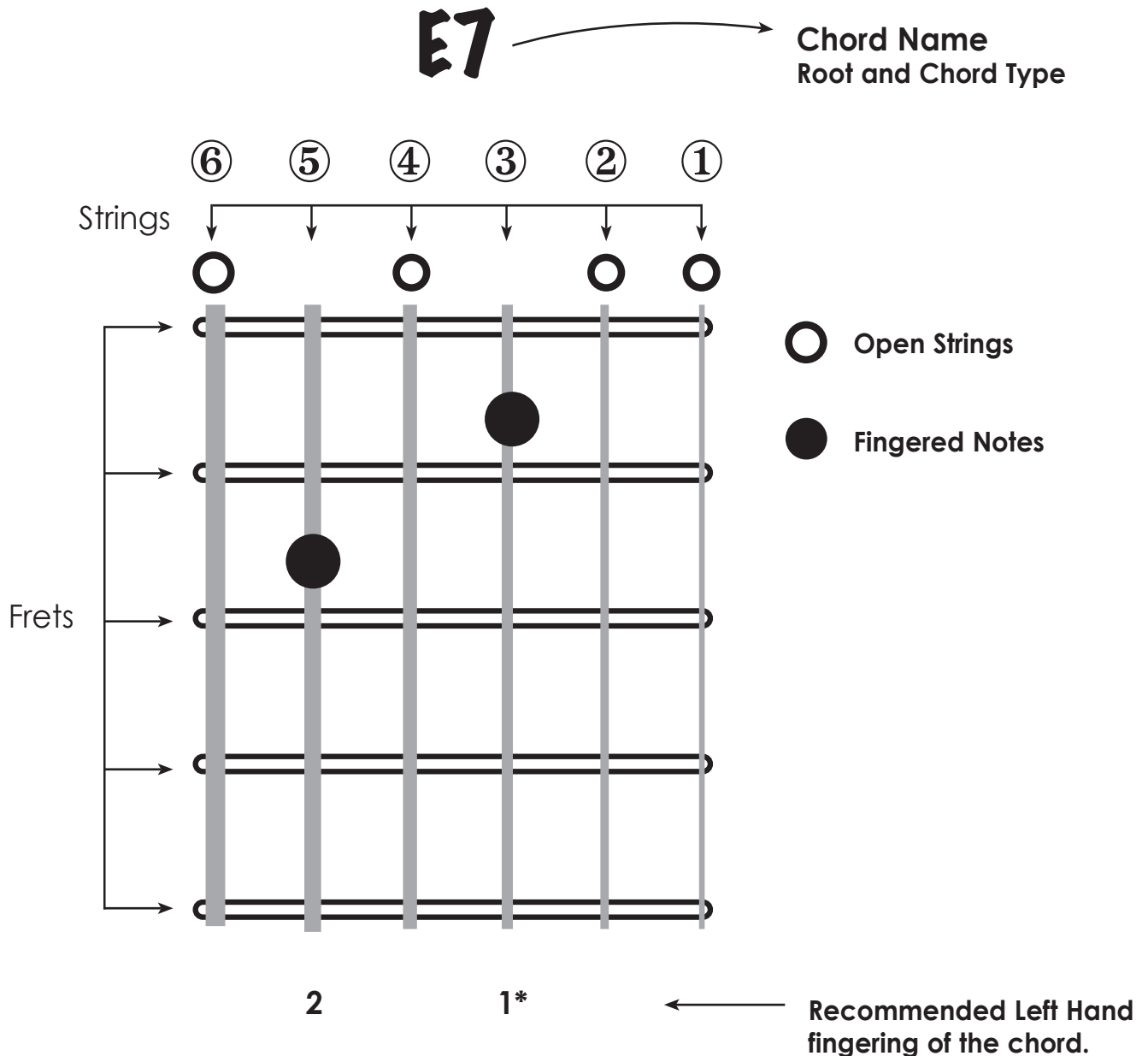




A typical guitar chord diagram.

The Guitar Chord Diagram Explained



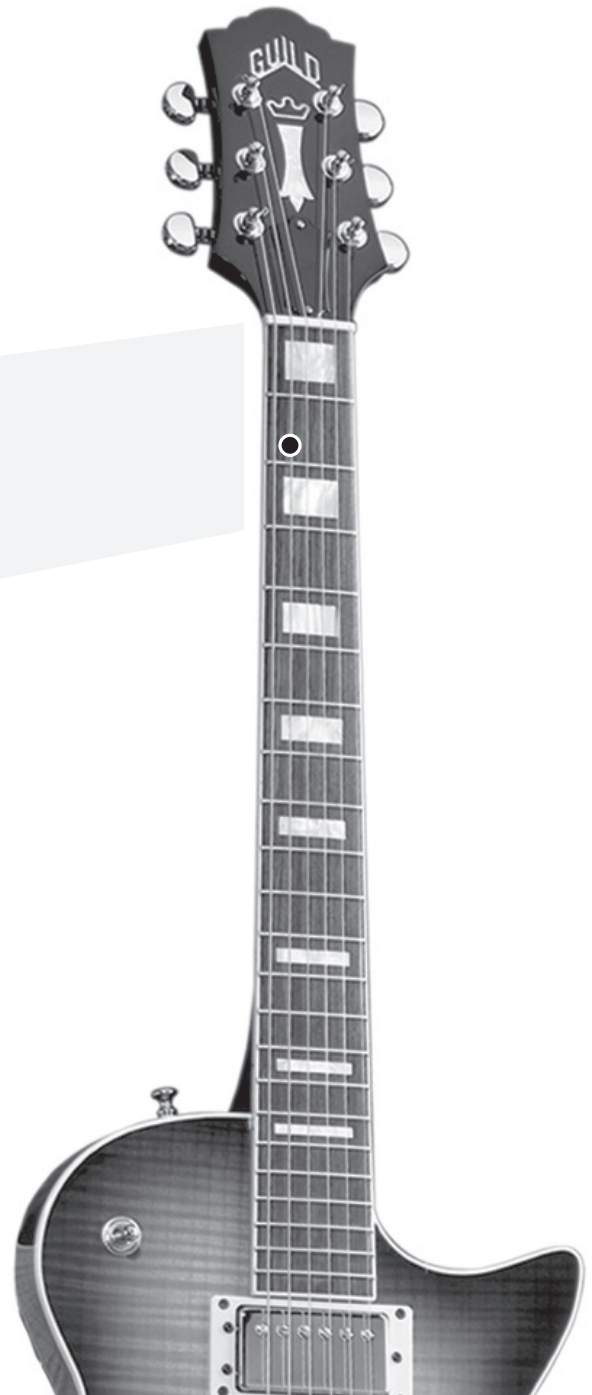
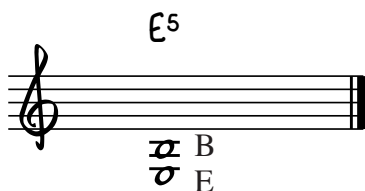
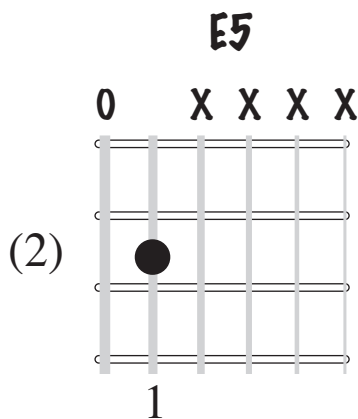
A typical guitar chord diagram.

Play string ⑥ open and
finger 1, string ⑤, fret (2).
Play both strings together.
